The next PA meeting will be on **Thursday 1st September** at 9:00 am.

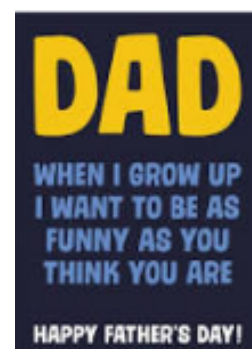

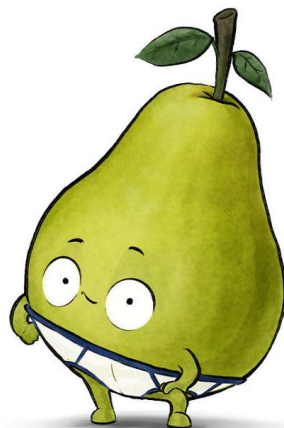
