Off-site Excursion:

Change of Dates:

Last week's newsletter had the wrong Transition Day date. Usually Grade Prep and Yr 7 Transition is the first Tuesday of December which is what I had in the newsletter. Apparently, this year it has been changed to the second Tuesday in December. I will still keep the Be PREPared Transition Day as the 6th December as per the brochure but the Yr 7 Statewide Transition Day will be on the 13th December. To clarify the following will happen:

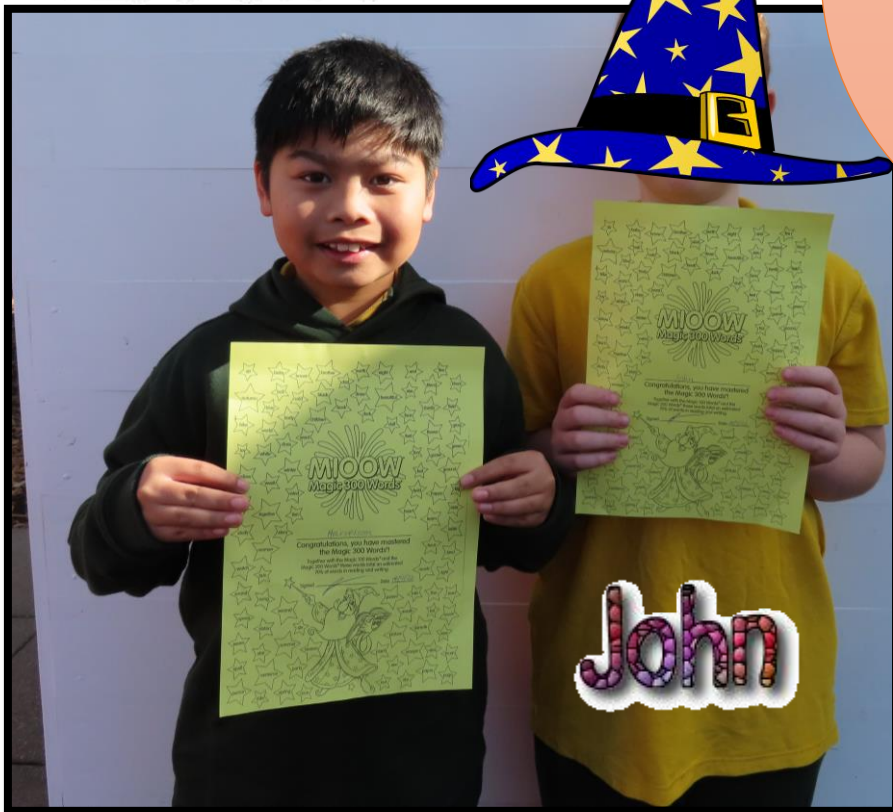

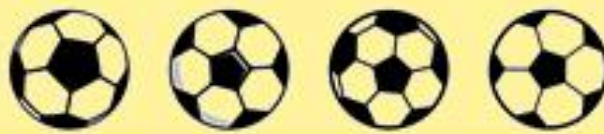

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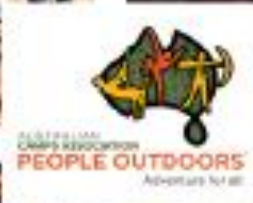
