3-6 Camp:

Permission forms were sent home last week. Please return these to school by Thursday 3rd November.

All students received a Confidential Medical Form & Medication Authorisation Form today.

All students must return the Confidential Medical Form. If they require medication on camp, they must return the Medical Authorisation Form as well. We cannot issue any medication without parent consent.

There is no cost for this camp. The Active Schools program will cover the cost of the camp and transport.

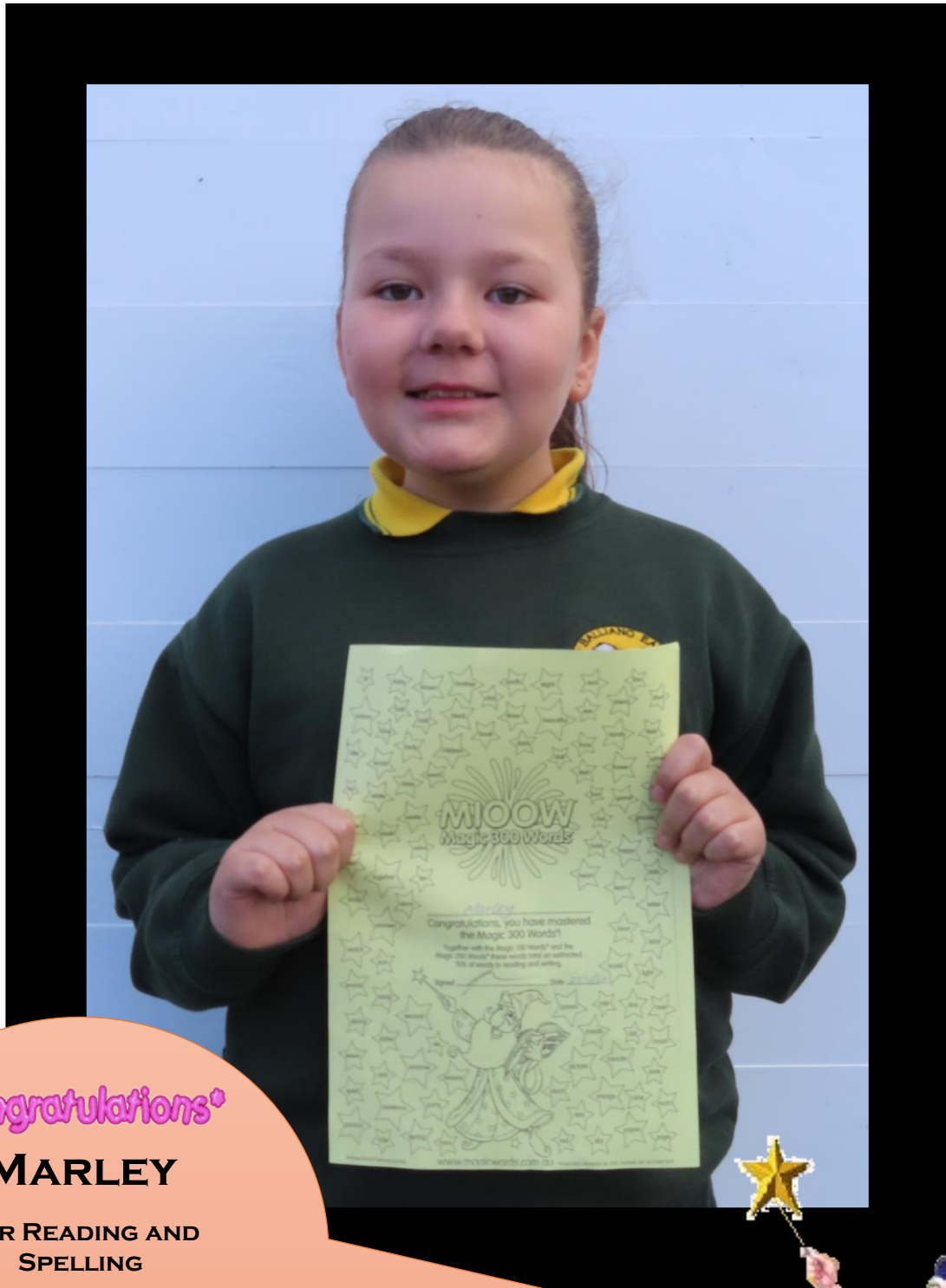
