






End of year activities/ events / reminders:

As there are many things to remember to do before the end of Term 4, we have included a brief description of each activity, particularly for our new families. If you have any further enquiries please speak to a staff member. On the back / bottom of this list there is a checklist which you can tick off as you complete each task:-

Christmas Raffle Donations:
