Reports:

All students will receive their mid-year report tomorrow.

There will be a glossary included which will explain abbreviated terms such as Reading Progress Test (RPT), what the assessment is measuring eg. comprehension, what the expected age is etc.

A detailed Attendance Report will be included with data taken directly from the DET Panorama site. This data provides absences from the past 5 years including the 2023 YTD data up until **Friday 9th June**. Any absences between the 9th June and the end of Term 2 will be highlighted in the end of year report.

Family holidays are counted in the absent data but do not cause us concern unless they become a constant reason for absences.

Students who have a consistent record of absences due to illness are the most concerning. Often 'illness' is a warning sign of the beginning of school refusal. If you have any concerns, please speak to a staff member so we can consider the next steps for these students.

If your child's attendance report has a comment at the bottom regarding a DET email then they have been red flagged by the Department as a significant concern.

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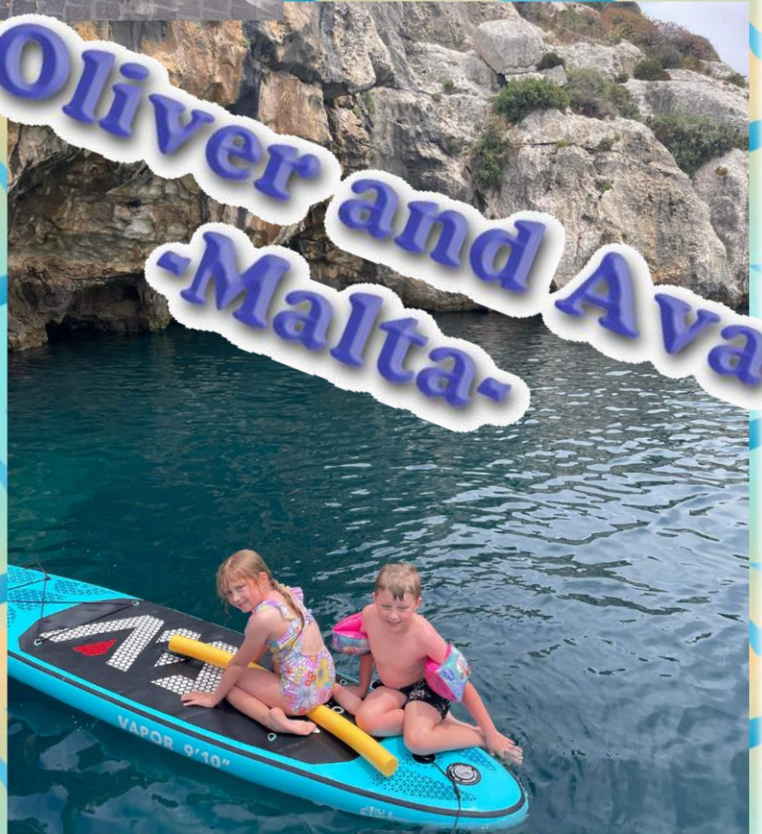
