BOOK PACK Information:

All students have received their Book Pack and fee structure letter today. Please read the following carefully to avoid any confusion: There are two components to the fees.

Part 1:

The book pack needs to be ordered and paid for online through the Rapid Office choice link below:

Click on the link and click the grade level/s your children are going to be in next year. Complete their details and add to cart.

Complete the payment option.

The book packs will be delivered directly to the school and the staff will have all items labelled ready for the start of the 2024 school year.

The Portal will close on Friday 8th December. If you miss the deadline you will incur an additional charge.

Part 2:

The first coloured page of the fee structure letter outlines the fees which need to be paid to the school.

Each Grade level has a green strip with the words 'Total Amount'. This is the amount due to the school.

This amount is made up of \$10:00 of shared items and \$55:00 for Extra-curricular activities – Total \$65:00 (Grade 1-5). Grade 6 is \$75:00 as this includes \$10:00 for their scrapbooking materials for their Year Book.

The additional \$26:50 is only for students who are transferring from another school to BEPS as this covers items which the current students have already paid for when they enrolled here.
