All students will be swimming at Salt Water Swim School in Bacchus Marsh next week. If possible, please have your child's bathers on under their uniform. If your child wears a one piece bathing outfit, you may prefer they don't put it on until they are at the pool.

All students will need a towel, swim bag or plastic bag for wet bathers, and dry underwear to put on after swimming. If your child uses goggles please make sure these are clearly labelled with their name or initials. Name all clothes items to avoid any confusion when uniforms need to be put back on the correct child – yes, it does happen.

Grade P-2 will be swimming from 1:00 – 1:45pm, Grade 3-6 will swim from 1:45 – 2:30pm.

All students will have their snack and lunch at school albeit at different times to the usual day.

If you have a child in Grade 3-6 and you live in Melton or Bacchus Marsh, you are welcome to collect them from the pool at 2:30pm after they have finished swimming, as long as you don't have to collect a younger sibling at school at 3:30pm.

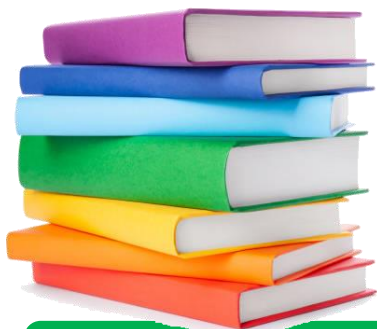
