Swimming – 4th-8th December:

Swimming lessons have been running well so far. There were a few small teething problems yesterday with the change rooms being a bit challenging for the size of our group however, this has been sorted and should run well for the rest of the week. At no stage will students be forced to feel uncomfortable getting changed. We have provided alternative ways to deal with this. The issue with the students going into cubicles yesterday was the amount of water left on the toilet floors which caused a significant slipping hazard, and the amount of time they were taking in individual cubicles which held up the space for others to use. It is very difficult to assist a child when they are struggling behind a closed door and don't let us know.

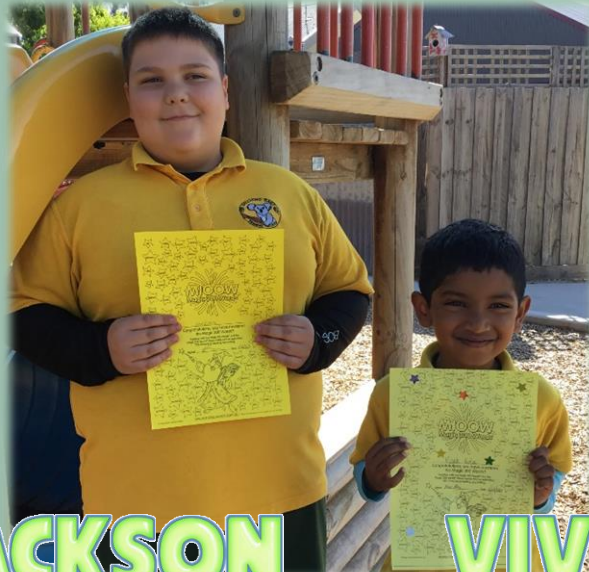

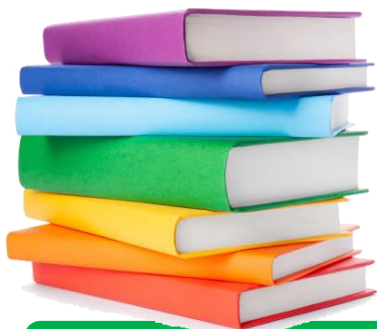

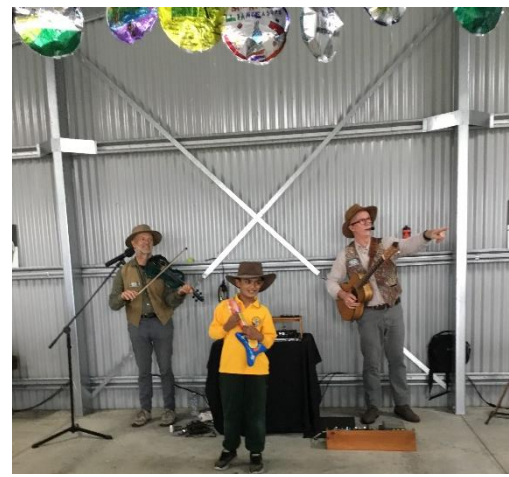
