Whole School Sports Day:

This Friday, 15th March, we will be attending the small school's Sports Day at Masons Lane, Bacchus Marsh. All students are expected to attend.

This year, students need to arrive at the sports ground between 8:30 – 8:40am. This will give us time to check their names off and hand out name tags and hats.

The students will be asked to assemble in their age groups at 8:50am ready for the first event so please avoid being late. Make sure you allow for the Bacchus Marsh school traffic at this time of the morning.

Parents are welcome to stay and follow their children to each of the events. Please bring snacks, lunch and drinks. There will be a coffee van for the adults.

The day usually winds up at around 2:00pm.

This day has normal school expectations. Students using devices/phones etc. between events, is not acceptable.

Ride AT School:

Due to the hot weather and unpredictability of snakes, our annual Ride to School will not be starting at Agars Rd. All student from P-6 can bring their bikes directly to school on Friday 22nd March and we will run bike safety sessions throughout the day on the oval and basketball court.

All students will need a bike in good working order and a helmet. Training wheels are fine. If your child does not have a bike, they may bring a scooter but be aware that this will limit their participation in some activities.


