  - think about the impact of our actions on other people

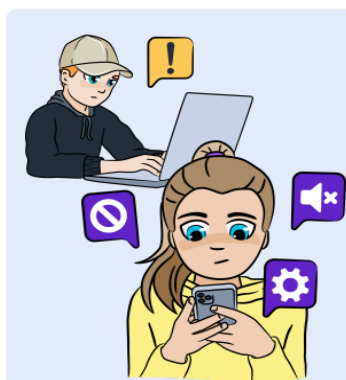


## Some conversation starters:

- What are your favourite things to do online that make you feel happy or relaxed?

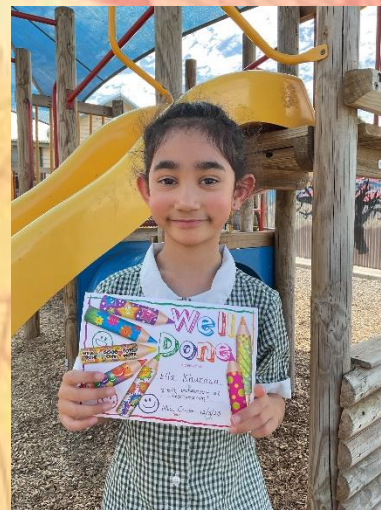
