## **Pie Warmers:**

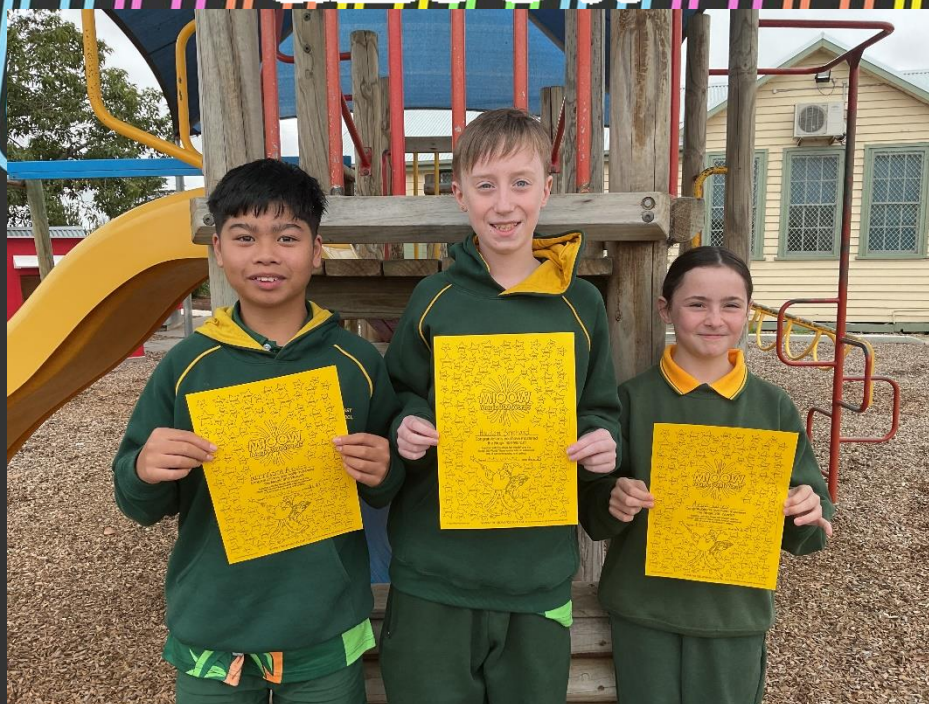

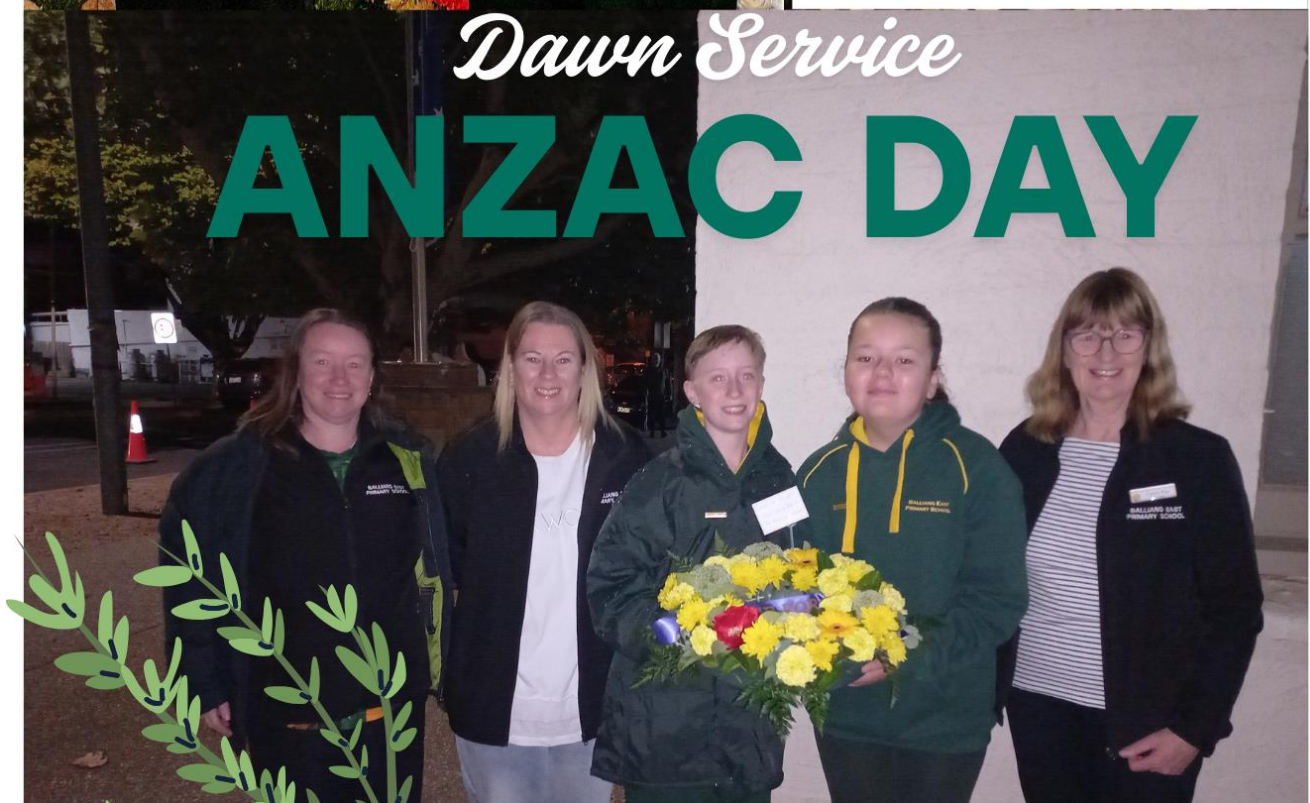
